



Background:- HUDCO, Regional office, Bhopal sponsored one project entitled “Empowerment of Tribble Youth in the District of Mandla in the State of Madhya Pradesh Facilitating Sustainable Livelihood Avenues” for one of the most backward Districts of Madhya Pradesh i.e. Mandla. The derivatives of this project were-

1. To motive the participants to opt for one of the training in one trade depending upon their interest and aptitude.
2. To provide complete technical training ‘up to the mastery level’ in the trade concerned.
3. To educate the participants about the techniques of managing the project opted by them.
4. To extend hand holding support to the participants to ensure that they successfully establish and manage their activity/venture.

Target Group: - This programme intended to generate Livelihood avenues for Tribble youth of Mandla Districts in the age group of 18 years to 45 years.

Strategy: - Skill Development Training Programmes for the targeted youth were organised as per NSQF norms in following trades-

1. Electrician Technician
2. Carpenter Wooden Furniture
3. Assistant Mason

Out Come: - about 75% of trained participants were deployed in self/wage employment.

Expenses on the Project: - 100% expenses incurred in executing this project were borne by HUDCO under their CSR initiatives.
